



## **First United Methodist Church**

**102 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St**

In 1891, the First Methodist Church moved to its current location on the corner of Adams Ave and North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. After a 1911 fire, the church contacted Sanguinet & Staats of Fort Worth to design the Romanesque Revival-style building. The new building was completed in 1914. The round sanctuary features Art Deco motifs throughout. Herringbone brick designs and inset stone cross medallions are featured on the exterior. Stunning stain glass windows were added in the mid 1960's.
