In The Mood Ballroom and Studio has truly blossomed under the ownership of Rudy and Karen Gonzales. The couple has dedicated an enormous amount of time and money into the three buildings on Main St. The couple purchased the ballroom in 1999 and quickly began renovations to transform the building into the lovely ballroom it is today. The building next door to the ballroom on 15 S Main St, has been transformed into a dance studio with New Orleans style iron work. The next building down on 17 S Main St has also received a facelift. The Gonzales' have breathed new life into the buildings on Main St.

. What began as just a humble wooden structure was later turned into the two brick structure by the early 1900's. A variety of business have been housed in the buildings on Main St. The McClellan 5 and dime store occupied the buildings from 1927 into the early 70's. Many McClellan items were unearthed during the renovations. Other businesses that have enjoyed the use of the buildings include Perry Brothers, a pharmacy, a Fair & Racket Store, a General Mercantile and a Tin Shop. The upstairs housed offices for Doctors, Dentists, Lawyers and Photographers.
