City of Temple, Texas
2013-2014 Annual Action Plan Amendment

The City of Temple received \$408,865 from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funds in 2013, which will be the fourth year of the 5-Year Consolidated Plan (2010-2014). The City also reallocated \$217,954 through the 2013-2014 Action Plan for a total of \$626,819 to be allocated. The Action Plan was submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), on July 23, 2013 and funding approval was received on September 20, 2013 with an effective date of October 01, 2013. In addition to the development of the 2013 Annual Action Plan, the City is proposing the following substantial amendment:

Reallocate 2013 Program Year CDBG funds that were allocated to the MLK Memorial Park Project to the Wilson Park Improvement Project

Wilson Park 2014 Playground Addition

Wilson Park 2014 Playground Addition will be located inside Wilson Park, 2205 Curtis B. Elliot Drive, near Clark Pool. This project will include design and installation of a playground, shade structure, picnic pavilion, swings, sidewalks, benches, grill, water fountain, trees, and boulder. A restroom facility will also be included if funding allows. It is recommended that \$227,819 be allocated from 2013-2014 CDBG funds to complete this project.

Two public meetings will be held to receive input from citizens residing in Temple regarding the proposed amendment to the Annual Action Plan.
