



Liquid Waste Ordinance FAQ - Transporter

Do I need to be permitted to haul liquid waste in the City of Temple?

Yes – A Liquid Waste Transporter Permit is required for all persons, entities or businesses engaged in the collection and transportation of applicable ordinance materials from facilities in the City of Temple, Texas.

How do I get a permit?

Permits are issued by the City of Temple upon submission, processing and approval of a completed Liquid Waste Transporter Permit 'Application', and a Liquid Waste Transporter Permit 'Agreement', together with all required accompanying information, and the payment in full of all applicable fees to the City of Temple. The 'Application' and 'Agreement' forms are available online at www.templetx.gov/transporter.

How much does a permit cost?

A liquid waste transporter permit is \$100 per transporting vehicle.

How long is a permit good for?

All transporter permits are valid for one (1) calendar year, running from January 1 through December 31.

Does the City of Temple have its own manifest?

Yes – The City of Temple has a numbered manifest system that transporters are required to use in order to track waste that is pumped and disposed of.

Where do I get the City of Temple manifest?

Manifest books cost \$15 and can be purchased from the City Of Temple, City Secretary's office located at 2 North Main Street, Suite 103 – Temple, TX.

When should I submit the manifest to the City of Temple?

Manifests must be submitted to the Environmental Programs office within 15 days of disposal at an approved location. Digital copies are accepted so long as they are **LEGIBLE**. Originals can be mailed to: 3210 E. Avenue H, Bldg A, #117 – Temple, TX 76501
